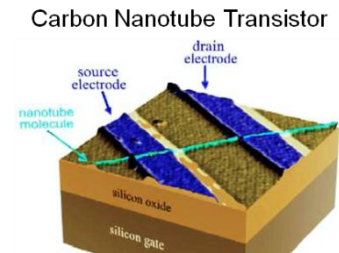


Nanotechnology for Electronics

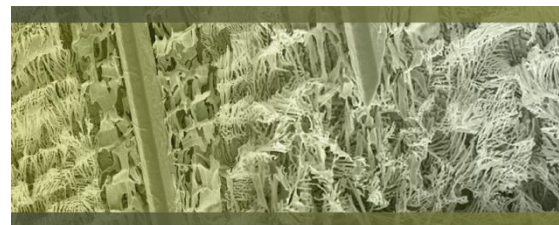
Program at a glance
